



## BASIC NEEDS for YOUTH

Teen Feed works with the community to **offer** support to meet basic needs, **build** strong relationships and **ally** with homeless youth as they meet their futures. We distribute basic needs items to youth as youth access support coordination, at the nightly Teen Feed Meal program and during the STOP Outreach program. **We rely on community members to help provide the following basic needs items for youth we serve:**

### Toiletries

- Travel-sized toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, styling products
- Combs and brushes
- First aid supplies
- Razors
- Dental floss
- Hand Sanitizer
- African American hair-care products

### Clothing

- New socks
- Gloves, hats, scarves
- Disposable hand warmers
- Hooded sweatshirts (L to XXXL, dark colors)
- Warm coats
- New underwear and boxers (men's & women's)

### Other Necessities

- Sleeping bags
- Backpacks
- Batteries – AA, AAA
- Battery operated travel alarm clocks
- Travel-sized sewing kits
- Journals and notebooks
- Flashlights
- Work boots
- Packets of bus tokens
- Discmen/ headphones
- Dried dog and cat food
